Helping your child at home:

<p>Good readers make for good writers. It is important that we support the children in becoming resilient learners who read for pleasure.</p> <p>Regular reading is essential in Year 3, so we ask for the children to be read with daily at home. We recommend that all children - even confident readers who prefer to read to themselves, are heard reading aloud daily. Reading at home can be recorded in your child's reading record.</p> <p>Visiting the library is a great way to get children excited about reading. There are various libraries local to us that will welcome you into their reading community: https://www.medway.gov.uk/directory/6/find_a_library</p>	<p>Please encourage your child to complete all written homework as this will greatly benefit their writing development. Your child will be sent home with new spellings every Wednesday.</p>	<p>The multiplication and division facts we are focusing on this half of term are the following:</p> <p>1X4 2X4 3X4 4X4 5X4 6X4</p> <p>By the end of Year 3 the children need to be fluent in the 2's, 3's, 4's, 5's, 8's and 10's times table.</p> <p>Children will practice their times tables daily at school please support this by frequently reciting them at home.</p> <p>Times Tables Rockstars: https://ttrockstars.com/</p>
