Further to my letter of 31st December, School will reopen on Tuesday 5th January for critical key worker and vulnerable children but again **only** if there is no alternative to childcare from a partner who is not a key worker or is unable to work from home.

We will follow health and safety as outlined in government guidance and in our risk assessments.

Chartwells will be on site and providing a hot school meal as per the menu, we are on week 1. If you would prefer your child to have a packed lunch please send one in with them. School packed lunches are not available.

The timings of the school day and the entrances will be as before, except for Miss Warren's class who will now use the office gate as the entrance and exit.

Children must remain with their parents/guardians and maintain social distancing until it is time for them to enter the school premises.
