

Activity ideas for 'Stickman'

- Read the story of Stickman and ask questions about the text. Pick out tricky words and see if they can read and spell them.
- Design a missing poster for Stickman can it include: Name, Where he was last seen, a picture of what he looks like and who to contact if someone sees him.
- Write a thank you letter from Stickman's family when he finally come back.
- Write a recount of a time when they might have lost something or even got lost themselves.
- Read other stories about getting lost i.e. Digger, Harriett Adrift. Read stories that have sticks in i.e. The Three Little Pigs, Stanley's Stick (youtube) get your child to imagine if they had a special stick what would it become?
- Enjoy other books written by Julia Donaldson – The Gruffalo's Child, Room on the Broom, Zog, Monkey Puzzle, The Smartest Giant, The Highway Rat etc
- Collect sticks for size ordering and sharing between 2, 3 and 4.
- Go on a bug/mini beast hunt. Count how many you find of each and make a pictograph.

- Craft ideas: collect sticks to make your own Stickman and family then role play the story using them.
- Make and cut out and make your own split pin Stickman.



- Make your own edible Stickman i.e. mini chocolate swiss roll for his body, chocolate matchstick makers, twix or chocolate fingers for arms and legs and white chocolate chips or jelly tots for eyes.
