

## Activity ideas for 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'

- Read the story 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and ask questions about the text, compare to a factual book and look at the differences
- Draw a caterpillar/butterfly and write simple sentences describing its colour, what it eats and how it moves
- Draw the life cycle of a butterfly and label it

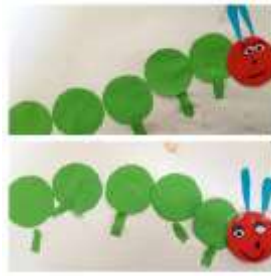


- Read 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird' and look at the similarities and differences between the two stories
- Draw the caterpillar you would like to be and write a sentence saying what your favourite food would be
- Read 'Creepy Crawlies Calypso', watch 'The Very Busy Spider' on Youtube and discuss the characters, settings and how the story might end differently
- Do a butterfly, caterpillar, mini beast hunt for 10 minutes and count how many you see
- Use fruit you have at home to do addition and subtraction work
- Make long and short caterpillars using playdough, dough string with beads, cherios etc.
