Rumble in the Jungle



This week we will be learning about wild animals in the jungle. We will be focusing on the book Rumble in the Jungle. (Can be found on You tube) I have listed lots of activities that you can do with your children and have included resources. Please feel free to explore this topic.

- Choose your favourite animal in the story. Draw, paint or make a face mask of this animal. I have include stick puppets in resources
- Read a non-fiction animal book with a grown-up, or research a jungle animal on line. What information have you learnt about animals? Can they share what they have learnt with family members?
- Play what am I? PowerPoint game based on Rumble in the Jungle characters. (This can be found in resources)
- Look at where jungles are found in the world. Look at maps and discuss how the jungle is different from where we live. (A jungle and Rainforest PowerPoint is in resources)



- Maths- I have included an animal addition sheet in resources, make sure the children count each item once and help them form the correct numbers.
- Shapes and patterns- Talk about the properties of triangles, squares and circles. (Sides, corners) Use shapes to make repeating patterns on snakes



- Sing a range of jungle animal songs: Down in the Jungle, five cheeky monkeys swinging on the tree, walking in the Jungle.
- Dance along to Hey Monkey on Cbeebies Boogie Beebies.
- Make a jungle in the garden for you animals
