



**Goldilocks and the Three bear**

- Help your child to compose a list of items you might need for the picnic
- Invite some of your soft toys to a picnic. Help your child to write the invitations. (I have included an invitation template in resources).
- Your child can help make the sandwiches, cakes or snacks for the picnic, using tools and listening to instructions is important.



- Play Teddy Bear's Picnic food hunt. Hide numbered food items around the garden and the children have to find them. (Picnic food hunt pictures can be found in resources).
- We cannot have the children's Bears in school, so we will be making split pin Bears for our picnic. (Split pin Teddy in resources)
- Look at the history of Teddy Bears. Can relatives talk about their Bears? (I have included a short PowerPoint about Bears)
- There are lots of maths games including Bears in Top Marks. These concentrate on number recognition, and using mathematical language, sorting by size.
